Over the past 5 years, more than \$50 Million has been generously given to churches and ministries through the *Excel In Giving* program. We want to see that number grow!


Apply to be a part of the *Excel In Giving* program and CEF will give your church or ministry \$250 to offset the cost of your electronic giving platform!
